The Council has also developed model curriculum for these Courses in alignment with Skill Assessment Matrix for Vocational Advancement of Youth (SAMVAY) as notified by MHRD under National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF). On successful completion of knowledge and Skill Competency required for each level, student will be awarded a Vocational Diploma / Vocational Degree (B.Voc) by the respective Board of Technical Education or the affiliating University of the State where the institution is located.

Further, it has been discussed as one of the Agenda in the Review Meeting held in the Tamil Nadu State Council for Higher Education on 11.06.2018.

To comply with the instructions of the Government, you are requested to get approval of AICTE, for any of the above mentioned courses to be offered in your College. After getting approval from the AICTE, this University will grant affiliation to such courses.
